Minutes of the Meeting: As per the agenda, the following points were discussed and resolved:

1. The coordinator of the committee welcomed all the members of the Anti-Ragging Committee and appreciated their presence and cooperation.
2. It was unanimously resolved to constitute an Anti-Ragging Flying Squad for the UG Department, including all UG Program Heads. Responsibilities related to anti-ragging measures will be assigned to each member.
3. It was decided to include a final-year UG student representative in the committee to ensure active student participation.
4. The committee resolved to display notice boards in UG blocks with the names and contact details of Anti-Ragging Committee members for easy accessibility.
5. It was decided to fix one specific day every month to conduct regular Anti-Ragging Committee meetings.
6. The committee and flying squad members will conduct periodic vigilance rounds in UG classrooms, corridors, and other common areas within the campus.
7. It was resolved to conduct an introductory and awareness session for first-year UG students regarding anti-ragging rules, committee members, and reporting mechanisms.
8. A vigilance team will be constituted to monitor UG hostels, with regular visits scheduled between 6:00 PM and 8:00 PM.




All members are requested to attend the meeting without fail.

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Introduction:

The Institution has constituted the Anti-Ragging Committee for the academic year 2025–26 to ensure a safe and supportive environment for all students. The following guidelines are framed to prevent the menace of ragging and to promote healthy interpersonal relationships on campus. Ragging in any form, within or outside the college premises, is strictly prohibited.


All students are required to familiarize themselves with the rules, regulations, and code of conduct related to anti-ragging measures and discipline. Heads of Departments (HODs) shall conduct awareness programs on anti-ragging for all newly admitted students during the Orientation Programme.

Objectives:

1. To create awareness among students about the dehumanizing effects and legal consequences of ragging.
2. To ensure a safe, respectful, and inclusive campus environment for all students.
3. To maintain continuous vigilance to prevent the occurrence and recurrence of ragging incidents.
4. To promptly address and take strict action against any reported cases of ragging.
5. To encourage students to report incidents without fear through proper grievance channels.
6. To promote healthy interaction and bonding between senior and junior students.
7. To educate students about their rights, responsibilities, and institutional policies.
8. To establish a supportive system for victims of ragging, including counselling and assistance.
9. To collaborate with faculty, hostel wardens, and student representatives for effective monitoring.
10. To strengthen preventive measures through regular awareness campaigns, workshops, and seminars.

Functions of the Committee:

1. To examine complaints received from students, conduct inquiries, and submit reports along with recommended disciplinary actions.
2. To maintain continuous vigilance and monitor student activities to prevent ragging.
3. To provide students with information regarding contact details of committee members for lodging complaints or distress calls.
4. To create awareness among students through campaigns, notices, and orientation programs.
5. To take necessary preventive measures against ragging within the campus and hostels.
6. To coordinate with hostel authorities and security staff for effective supervision.
7. To maintain records of complaints, actions taken, and follow-up measures.


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
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Anti Ragging committee Notification

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**ACTIVITIES AMOUNTING TO RAGGING
AND**

SCOPE OF ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

According to the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009, measures have been established to prohibit, prevent, and eliminate ragging in colleges.

1. Activities Amounting to Ragging

Ragging includes any act by a student or group of students that causes **physical, mental, or emotional harm** to a fresher or any other student. These include:

1. **Teasing or rude behavior** through spoken words, writing, or actions.
2. **Rowdy or in disciplined activities** that may cause:
 - Annoyance
 - Hardship
 - Physical or psychological harm
 - Fear or apprehension
3. **Forcing students to perform acts** they would not normally do, leading to:
 - Shame
 - Embarrassment
 - Mental or physical distress
4. **Disrupting academic activities** of any student or fresher.
5. **Exploiting juniors** for completing academic work assigned to others.
6. **Financial extortion**, including forcing students to spend money.
7. **Physical abuse**, including:
 - Sexual abuse
 - Forcing obscene acts
 - Causing bodily harm or danger
8. **Verbal or online abuse**, such as:
 - Insults (spoken, email, or social media)
 - Deriving pleasure from others' discomfort
9. **Acts affecting mental health and confidence**, including:
 - Showing power or superiority

- Causing emotional distress

2. Administrative Action in the Event of Ragging

If a student is found guilty of ragging, the institution will take strict action as per rules.

Decision-Making Authority:

- The Anti-Ragging Committee evaluates each case.
- Decisions are based on:
 - Facts of the incident
 - Severity (nature and gravity)
 - Recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad

3. Punishments for Ragging

Depending on the seriousness of the offense, one or more of the following punishments may be imposed:

1. Suspension from classes and academic privileges
2. Withholding or withdrawal of scholarships/fellowships
3. Debarring from exams or evaluation processes
4. Withholding of results
5. Debarring from representing the institution in events
6. Suspension or expulsion from hostel
7. Cancellation of admission
8. Rustication (1 to 4 semesters)
9. Expulsion from the institution and ban from other institutions for a specified period

If the offenders are **not identified**, collective punishment may be applied.

Ragging is a **serious punishable offense** that harms students' **dignity, safety, and mental well-being**.
Strict rules and penalties ensure a **safe and respectful academic environment** for all students.



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
